NOTIFICATION

In the existing proviso of Para second of rule 119 of the Karnataka Forest Manual 1976 the following shall be substituted.

“On receipt of the application in Form No.31, the Deputy Conservator of Forests / Range Forest Officer will refer it with his observations for determination of ownership of the trees”:-

(A) To the jurisdictional Assistant Commissioner when any of the tree/trees is /are of “reserved species” defined so under section 2(15) of the Karnataka Forest Act 1963 but excluding Bite (Dalbergia latifolia) and Catechu (Acacia catechu) which has separate provisions.

(B) To the jurisdictional Tahsildar when the tree/trees are neither of the species Bite (Dalbergia latifolia), Catechu (Acacia catechu) and Sandalwood (Santalum album) nor fall in the list of “reserved species” defined so under section 2(15) of the Karnataka Forest Act 1963.

The certification of ownership of trees issued by the Assistant Commissioner or Tahsildar, as the case may be, will be sufficient for deciding the issuance of transit passes by the Deputy Conservator of Forests / Range Forest Officer.

This will come into effect from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
