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General Conditions:

- 1) Only PWD registered contractors as Class-II and above and registered as Forest Contractors in this division during the year 2019-20 can apply.
- 2) Tenders from Joint ventures are not acceptable.
- 3) Tenderer shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility. If the tenderer found for corrupt and fraudulent practices as per the prevailing rules in force their tenders are liable to be rejected.
- 4) The tenderer shall ensure credit of tender processing fee and EMD into the respective receiving bank accounts of e-Procurement portal on or before the last date of the bid submission.
- 5) The tenderer should not be a defaulter in any of the Government Departments.

- 6) EMD Payments through e-Payment mode shall be made as one single transaction and payments made in part are liable for rejection.
- 7) Conditional tenders will not be accepted.
- 8) The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his tender, and the Department is not responsible and liable for those costs.
- 9) Successful tenderer must enter into an agreement with department Rs. 100 bound paper within 5 days from the date of intimation.
- 10) Date of completion of works shall be completed within 90 days from the date of agreement and not later than 15-02-2020 in any case.
- 11) Taxes, duties, cesses, etc., as applicable will be deducted from the payment.
- 12) The tenderer shall produce address proof such as EPIC, ADHAR or Residential Certificate issued by the concerned revenue authority.
- 13) Royalty and other taxes will be deducted as per prevailing Government orders.
- 14) As per GO No. : LD/300/LET/2006/ dt : 18-01-2007, 1% of the bill amount will be deducted against labour welfare fund.
- 15) All scanned documents to be uploaded shall be in original and the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar Division, and Bidar reserves the right to verify the documents before approval.
- 16) The check measurement of the works will be taken up by the Assistant Conservator of Forests concerned in presence of the contractor. The contractor shall sign and endorse the measurements.
- 17) All the works are to be executed by following the prevailing provisions in Code/Manual and other relevant departmental instructions, circulars etc.
- 18) The successful Tenderer shall deliver to the Department as Security deposit for an amount equivalent to 5% of the contract sum in the form of demand draft issued by any nationalized banks in favour of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar Division, Bidar before entering into the contract.
- 19) Payments will be made to contractor subject to availability of funds from the Government. No interest will be paid for delayed payments.
- 20) Contractor should take all precautionary measures to avoid any damage to the utilities, vegetation during excavation as well as utility shifting. To that extent the contractor should indemnify the department.
- 21) Contractor should follow strictly the prevailing labour acts & rules and pay wages to the labourers as per law.
- 22) The tenders shall abide by the rules& regulations of this department.
- 23) It should be clearly understood that the quantities shown in the schedule are approximate and or liable to modifications or may vary. The tender rates of each and every items shall hold good for full duration of the contract irrespective of change in the designs or quantities or any increase in cost and materials, labour etc.,
- 24) In case of dispute the decision of the next higher authority accepting the tender shall be final and binding.
- 25) The contractor and his workers are deemed to be subjected to Forest Acts and Rules for works to be executed in Forest areas.
- 26) No advance payment will be made but payments shall be made on bill or bills after completion of work and as preferred by the contractor through the concerned Range Forest Officers to this office after check measurements by the Assistant Conservator of Forests.
- 27) That the quantities and specifications shown in the schedule are approximate and are liable to modifications or alterations as may be found necessary and subject to availability of funds.
- 28) In the event of any failure on the part of the contractor to execute the work both of quality and quantity to the satisfaction of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar , the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar shall be at liberty to make such alternative arrangements as necessary for the successful completion of the contract at the risk of the contractor and loss if any to the Government from such arrangements shall be recoverable from the contractor as arrears of land revenue and he shall not be entitled for the savings arising there from besides forfeiting from the security deposit furnished.
- 29) The locations of all the works indicated in the notification may be changed depending upon the field conditions in the same or other range. The contractor should execute the works in the changed locations.
- 30) Compensation to workmen, the tenderer shall pay compensation (as per workmen compensation act in force) to the disabled worker under him for any injury or death caused

- or occurred during the Excavation of work, failing which the amount will be deducted from the bills and paid to the injured or the legal heirs of the deceased.
- 31) The supply of chain-link mesh and barbed wire will be done by the department as per the circular of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Bangalore. The tenderer should abide by this condition.
 - 32) Contractor should carry out the work as per package of practice under the direction of concerned Range Forest Officer and Assistant Conservator of Forests. The work should be carried out without causing any damage to the existing trees or plants and in case of damage, the Contractor shall be held responsible and he will be liable to any legal action and penalty as decided by the Deputy Conservator of Forests.
 - 33) In case of disputes the decision of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar is binding on the contractor and the subordinate officers. Any appeals on the orders of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar may be preferred with the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kalaburagi Circle, Kalaburagi and the orders of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kalaburagi will be final.
 - 34) The tenderer should quote the rate in lumpsum or in percentage less / equal / excess i.e., for entire unit amount not for individual work. If the rates quoted to individual work, that will not be considered.
 - 35) The preparation of estimates charges and scrutiny charges will be paid to concerned officers of this division.
 - 36) The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar has reserved the right to add or delete or give the relaxation of any of the condition.
