Preamble:


As per the above subject "Ease of Doing Business implementation of Business reform Action plan 2017" is a Government of India and Government of Karnataka initiative vide under reference, it is informed to implement the proposed action points. In pursuance Forest department has designed and developed a web based system for online submission of application for felling and transportation of trees in private lands and made available at departments website <http://aranya.gov.in> Field inspections by officers at different levels are to be carried out in the proposed system and inspection reports of the same are to be uploaded within specified time. So as to enable public to view and download the inspection reports.

As per the provision under section 8(3) of Karnataka preservation of trees Act, 1976, field inspection report prepared by officers should be uploaded online in the software application within 48 hours of inspection. Hence, the order.

ORDER

As explained in preamble, for online submission of request related to felling and transportation of trees in private lands a web based system has been developed and available in the departments website <http://aranya.gov.in> The reports generated as per the provisions under section 8(3) of Karnataka preservation of trees Act, 1976, field inspecting officers shall upload the field inspection report in the online system within 48 hours of inspection. Necessary actions shall be taken as per the order.
